ADDITIONAL RULES:

1. Entry must be the work of the exhibitor.
2. Secure exhibit tag to your entry with a pin.
3. All entries are to be in clear plastic bags and on a plate.
4. No mixes are to be used unless specified.
5. Baking to be received between 6:30 p.m. & 8:00 p.m. Tuesday or between the hours of noon and 8:00 p.m. Wednesday, and to remain in place until 6:00 p.m. Sunday. Entries to be picked up between 6:00-8:00 pm Sunday.

- All entrants into the contest must submit entries that were made using the sponsor's product.
- A product label must accompany each entry as proof of purchase. ACH Foods will require only one proof of purchase from either Mazola Corn Oil or Bee Hive Corn Syrup.

Best homemade Sticky Buns. Judging will be based on appearance, taste, texture and recipe creativity. PRIZES: 1st: \$15.00 plus gift prize, 2nd: \$10.00 plus gift prize.

41. 60% WHOLE WHEAT BREAD COMPETITION

Rules:

1. Bread entry must be solely made by the person entering the competition.
2. The entrant must have won the 60% Whole Wheat Bread Competition at the local Fair/Exhibition to be eligible to enter the District Competition.
3. The entrant must have won the District Competition to be eligible to enter the Ontario Association of Agricultural Societies Competition at the convention in 2009. The Convention winner will become the OAAS Ontario Bread Baker Champion for the year.
4. Pan size: (these are the measurements for the top of the pan that must be used for the final Convention Competition)
Minimum size: 8" x 4" x 2 1/2" (20 cm x 10 cm x 7 cm)
Maximum size: 9" x 5" x 3" (23 cm x 13 cm x 7.5 cm)
5. A full loaf of 60% whole wheat bread is required to be shown.
6. District winners must send to the committee by January 15, 2012 their recipe for entry on the card provided and signed "consent to publish" form.
7. Exhibit (loaf of bread) must be in a clean, clear, plastic bag, tagged with the exhibitor's name, address, and District represented using the entry tag provided.
8. Entries will be received in the Ontario Room on the Convention Floor from 7:30 to 8:30 a.m. on the Friday morning of the convention. Judging will commence at 9:30 a.m. Bread will be judged according to OAAS Home-craft Judging Standards.

ADDITIONAL RULES:

1. All items must be in standard canning jars only, in the sizes specified in section.
2. No wax. No food colouring. Two piece lids only.
3. Entries to be received as per entry outline at the beginning of Home & Garden Division.
4. Entries must be labeled with name and date of preparation (within 1 yr. prior to judging date).
5. Entry tags to be attached with rubber band to the neck of jar.

PRIZES: 1st: \$4.00, 2nd: \$3.50; 3rd: \$3.00

Note: Items 1-7 must be in 500 ml jars **ONLY**.
