

(b) the Rules Committee has a reasonable belief that there would be a violation of the Rules and Regulations for Showing Holstein Cattle if the exhibitor's animal is shown.

If the exhibitor decides not to show the animal after receiving such a warning, no violation of the Rules and Regulations will be considered to have occurred and no disciplinary measures will be taken against the exhibitor. The Rules Committee will only give the above warning to an exhibitor or exhibitor's representative where the committee considers it reasonable and practical to do so and not in circumstances of disqualification of entries under the Rules and Regulations.

7. The Rules Committee shall have the option, following the judging of the milking classes, to ultrasound the udders, prior to milk-out, of a representative number of animals in each of the milking classes, or to take milk samples from a representative group of animals. If the Rules Committee undertakes the option to ultrasound the udders or to take milk samples, it shall make an announcement to this effect before the judging of the milking classes.

1. Female, Heifer - Sept. 1, 2010 to Feb. 28, 2011
2. Female, Junior Yearling - Mar. 1, 2010 to Aug. 31, 2010
3. Female, Senior Yearling - Sept. 1, 2009 to Feb. 28, 2010
4. Female, Two Year Old - Sept. 1, 2008 to Aug. 31, 2009. In milk or dry or not yet calved for the first time.
5. Female, Three Year Old - born Sept. 1, 2007 to Aug. 31, 2008. In milk or dry. If dry, must be within 6 weeks of calving.
6. Female, Four Year Old - Born Sept. 1, 2006 to Aug. 31, 2007. In milk or dry. If dry must be within 8 weeks of calving.
7. Female, Five Year Old - Born Sept. 1, 2005 to Aug. 31, 2006. In milk or dry. If dry must be within 8 weeks of calving.
8. Female, Mature Cow - born prior to Sept. 1, 2004. In milk or dry. If dry, must be within 8 weeks of calving.
9. Breeder's Herd, bred and owned by exhibitor. Group of 3 animals. Each animal in the group must have exhibited in one of the classes for single animals. The registration certificate for each respective animal must show the exhibitor as "breeder" and "owner", in both cases may be a "joint owner" of an animal. All the animals must be from one farm or breeding unit.
10. Best Udder Class - Judges shall designate best two udders in Sections 5, 6, 7 & 8. These designated exhibits shall compete for first and second best udders in the show. Prize money to be paid first and second placings only.
