3. Baled Hay first cut, legume other than alfalfa 85% legume
4. Baled Hay, first cut, 85% grass
5. Baled Hay, other than first cut legume, 85% legume
6. Baled hay other than first cut mixed 30% grass or legume

## CLASS 38 - Commercial Corn. Variety Named

1. 6 Stalks of ensilage corn (no roots)
2. 6 ears of Hybrid Field corn
3. 1/2 Bushel lot Hybrid Field corn
4. 1-Gallon shelled corn (Can be from previous year)

## CLASS 39 - Grain & Soybeans. Variety Named

1. Soybeans 6 plants (no roots)
2. Soybeans 1 Gallon soybean seed from previous year
3. Oats 1 Gallon
4. Barley 1 Gallon
5. Red Clover seed 1kg
6. Timothy seed 1 kg
7. Alfalfa seed 1 kg
8. Trefoil seed 1 kg
9. Haylage 1 Gallon
