Exhibitor or a member of the immediate family must be a member of the Canadian Hackney Society. Hackney mares or geldings are to be used and shown in hand. No entry fee required.
Prize Money - \$20.00, \$18.00, \$15.00, \$12.00, \$10.00
2. Single Hackney Horse or Pony - driven by a Junior Exhibitor. Sponsored by the St. Catharines Riding and Driving Club (also eligible for points by the Hackney Society), open to all registered Hackneys (mares or geldings), suitable to be driven by a Junior. To be shown to a suitable four-wheeled vehicle. To have a long mane and tail, or short tail and braided mane. To be shown by a boy or girl under the age of 18 years as of January 1 of the current year. Exhibitor or member of the immediate family must be a member of the Canadian Hackney Society. To be judged on manners, quality and performance of the animal and the drivers ability; 50% for the driver's ability and 50% for the suitability of the animal. Cross entries permitted.
