Liability coverage to be sent in with entries.

1. All sheep must be on the grounds by 10:00 a.m. and remain until 5:00 p.m.
2. Each exhibitor must be a member of the Smithville Agricultural Society. (\$7.00 membership fee if not retained from prior year.)
3. Entries should be sent in by August 25, 2011.
4. Exhibitor may only show a maximum of two entries in no more than two sections for a single animal.
5. There must be two exhibitors per class. Where there is only one it is the discretion of the committee and judge on grouping classes.
6. All sheep must be shown in the ring and remain in the ring until placings have been recorded.
7. All sheep must be shown in short fleece (less than 1") except for long wool breeds.
8. Exhibitors must be residents in District 4.
9. **All sheep must be owned by the exhibitor, be registered with CLRC in the name of the exhibitor, and tattooed with registration numbers.**
10. Exhibitor sign should be on display for spectators.
11. Exhibitors are allowed to show in a max. of two purebred breeds.
12. No bedding supplied.
